CPCS Slinger/Signaller (A40)



This course provides practical and theoretical knowledge to allow inexperienced operators to undertake slinging and signalling for the movement of loads using lifting equipment as defined in BS 7121.

Successful candidates will receive a Red CPCS Trained Operator card endorsed with the Slinger/Signaller category¹.

Course Content

- ▼ Knowledge of the legislation and associated standards relating to lifting and signalling, including BS 7121.
- ▼ Roles and responsibilities of workers involved in lifting tasks.
- ▼ Documentation and certification of lifting equipment.
- ▼ Lifting accessories, their use and attachment to loads.
- ▼ Slinging techniques, downrating and angles.
- ▼ Establishing weights and centres of gravity.
- ▼ Proximity hazards.
- ▼ Communications via hand signals and radios.
- ▼ CPCS Technical Test for category A40.

Completion of the NVQ Level 2 Diploma in Controlled Lifting Operations within two years of this course leads to award of a CPCS Blue Competent Operator card.
